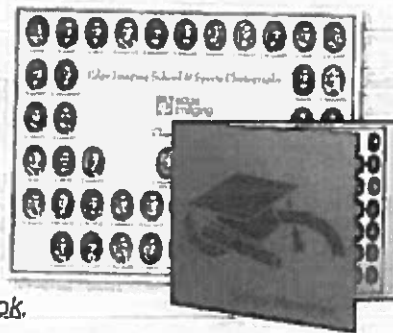


## Graduating Class Composite
