

Parent Message – Nov. 11, 2021

1. This is a reminder that selected students will be writing the Literacy Test on Thursday, November 18 (next week).
 - Only students who have been contacted and know that they are writing that day come to school
 - A reminder that detailed test information is listed on the AVSS website, including practice test information, when students can leave the school after the test, etc.
 - **Students who are not writing the Literacy Test DO NOT come to school on the 18th. They are to log into their classes electronically on the 18th and complete work that they have discussed with their teacher ahead of time – including students in the Transitions Room.**
 - Students in Developmental classes should come to school on the 18th

2. There has been a noticeable improvement in the choices our students are making, but I am going to continue to ask for parent/guardians to help repeat the message we have been announcing to students for a few weeks:
 - *Please be respectful by staying off our neighbours' property during the school day
 - *Also remember that once you make the choice to leave school property during school hours, you are responsible for your own actions. The best place for you to be is in school at all times.

3. Teachers will be submitting MIDTERM REPORT CARD MARKS next Tuesday, November 16 – and that means two things:
 - a) NOW is the time for students to submit all missing or late assignments in time for them to be included on the report card mark
 - b) Report cards will be out to parents/students shortly after the 16th – stay tuned for more details
